Upon a roll-call vote being taken, the motion was carried with Mr. Bryant, Ms. Dooley, Dr. Kraft, Ms. McKeever, Mr Morse, Ms. Torres, voted yes. 6 ayes, 0 nays.

**7.1 Approval - Private Fiber Network Project:** Pat Cuomo, Director of Technology, presented information on the proposed Private Fiber Network Project at the February 3, 2022 meeting. At that meeting the Board requested information on the possibility of future expansion to communities and neighborhoods in Charlottesville. Ms. Powell presented information on how other cities have completed similar projects and shared a cost estimate of how much it could potentially cost to expand the network.

Ms. McKeever made a motion, seconded by Ms. Dooley, to approve the proposed Private Fiber Network Project. Upon a roll-call vote being taken, the motion was carried with Mr. Bryant, Ms. Dooley, Dr. Kraft, Ms. McKeever, Mr Morse, Ms. Torres, voted yes. 6 ayes, 0 nays.

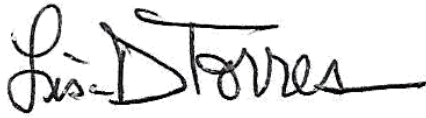
Ms. Powell shared details on why Charlottesville City Schools per pupil expenditure (PPE) is ranked 7th in the State.
