



Accreditation Glossary

Combined Rates - students who either passed the Standards of Learning (SOL) assessments or, if they did not pass, demonstrated significant growth. They also include English Learners (ELs) who made progress toward English proficiency.

Denominator - total tests, including recovery (counted twice)

English Learner (EL) Progress - is counted when an English learner student fails the test but shows progress towards English proficiency

Growth - students that did not pass the test but showed significant improvement and counts in the numerator

Passing - is how many students actually passed the test

Recovery - a student did not pass the previous school year, received remediation support, and passes the next year. The passing test is counted twice in the numerator and denominator.

State Benchmark - 75% for English and 70% for math and science
