Albemarle Regional Migrant staff will complete the required Migrant Certification of Eligibility (COE), submit it to VA Department of Education, and maintain current student records on file. We will keep your Migrant Contact informed of support for Migrant students within your division and collaborate to develop appropriate services.

If you do not return the signed form, the Albemarle Regional Migrant Education program will not be able to provide services to any Migrant students currently residing in your division, or to identify and serve new eligible students.
