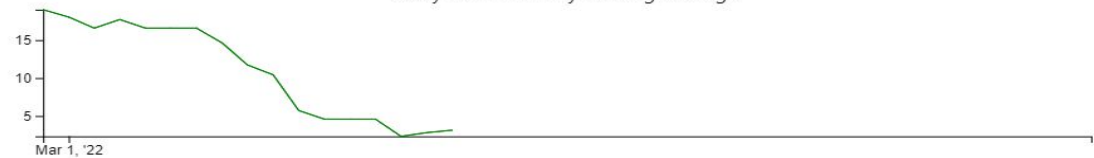

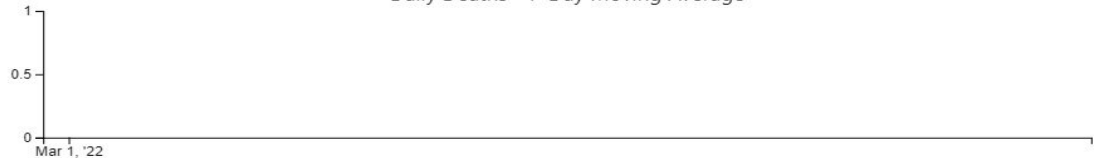

Proposed COVID plans for remainder of year

- Policy - Proposed revision to include optional, but encouraged, masking for employees.
- For remainder of the school year, weekly testing at each school will continue and will be required for employees who are not vaccinated.
- Vaccinations are available at schools and requests will be made with BRHD for booster clinics or assistance for employees.
- Contact tracing will occur at schools as is necessary and only reported to BRHD for potential outbreaks.
- For co-curricular activities, the capacity of attendees will not be limited but masks will be encouraged.
- Continue masking on buses until at least May 3 (per CDC guidance).
