

#### Accomplishments

### **Definition of Giftedness**

We recognize that the need for students to think and perform at high levels is important for cultivating their potential for advanced learning.

## **Goals in Six Areas**



#### 1. Identification:

• Provide an identification process with a talent development perspective that identifies diverse students from all populations and supports the division's service delivery models.

#### 2. Delivery of Services:

- Provide students with appropriately challenging educational opportunities that address their learning needs and help them develop their talents to the fullest potential.
- 3. Curriculum and Instruction:
  - Provide differentiated curricular options, instructional approaches and resource materials that support the needs of learners in a talent development framework.

## **Goals in Six Areas**



#### 4. <u>Professional Development</u>:

• Provide consistent and ongoing professional learning to school staff around best practices in developing the talents of all learners.

#### 5. Equitable Representation of Students:

- Use qualitative and quantitative data to identify and develop the talents of all students, including those in historically underrepresented groups.
- 6. Parent and Community Involvement:
  - Enrich and expand parent, school staff and community understanding of talent development as a framework for gifted education.
