


How do you prefer to receive essential, but non-emergency, school-related information about your child's district?



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


How do you prefer to receive essential, but non-emergency, school-related information about your child's district?




Students who are not enrolled in summer academy classes can still request free meals at summer school locations. The family can visit the school office during meal times to request a student meal.

We had a very nice field trip to the Kluge-Ruhe Indigenous Austrailian Art Museum. We got to look at Highlights of Our Week different works of art including paintings and stop-motion videos. We also talked about the geography of the Great Victoria Desert where the artwork originated.

In roading, we did an author study of Andrea Beaty by reading her books and responding in writing. The students wrote about their ideas for inventions and created a building after reading Izzy Peck, Architect.

In math, we started a new unit of looking at numbers arranged in arrays. The unit prompts students to think about rooms and floors in a building as a visual of repeated addition/multiplication.

In Social Studies, we learned about Indigenous Nations and Tribes that lived in the Plains Region. We discussed geography, natural resources, homes, transportation, and contributions.



Dear CHS community -

This afternoon, CHS began experiencing some water issues. Immediately after school, the City shut off the school's water and began making repairs. While they are making good progress, we wanted to give you an update.

CHS May Have Schedule Changes Tomorrow, Including 2-Hour Delay or Cancellation

An on-time start at the high school is possible for tomorrow. But it is also possible that CHS
will have a 2-hour delay or the school may even be closed tomorrow if they are unable to
restore water to the building.

All Other Schools Will Follow Normal Schedules

To be clear, all other schools will follow normal schedules, including CATEC. If CHS is delayed or cancelled, CHS students who attend CATEC can attend classes if they can supply transportation.

Timing of Further Updates

- . If the City has a further update, we will let you know by 10pm tonight.
- Otherwise, we will give you an update around 6am tomorrow.









- 140+ media stories so far this year (not counting most sports stories)
