What is the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)

- Community eligibility allows schools to offer breakfast and lunch to all students at no cost.
- Removes the burden of processing free & reduced household applications
- Uses Directly Certified/Categorically Eligible student data as of April 1st of the prior school year
- Provision program that operates on a 4-Year Cycle
- Eliminates negative balances

Charlottesville City Schools CEP Growth

- SY 2018-2019 The district began participating in program at Johnson, Jackson Via and Clark.
- SY 2021-2022 The district added Walker, Buford and CHS.
- SY 2023-2024 The district submitted an application to add Burnley-Moran, Greenbrier and Venable.



Success of Participating in CEP

- Increased participation
- Eliminate negative balances
- Erased stigma of free lunch



Where we Stand in the Application Process

- Our application currently says pending approval.
- It may take several weeks for our application to say final approval
- They work in the order that applications have been received.
- All of our CEP numbers have been validated.
- DOE has communicated we can move forward with the plans to implement CEP district wide.
