# OF NOTE:

Pre-K PALS does not create a summed score for rating for four-year-olds, so that children can be “PALS ID’ed” as it does for kindergarten and up, so each component has to be reviewed separately.

Pre-K PALS will be one of the four components of Virginia Kindergarten Readiness Program (VKRP) data once it is compiled this summer.

## DEFINITIONS:

**MEAN:** average of a set of numbers

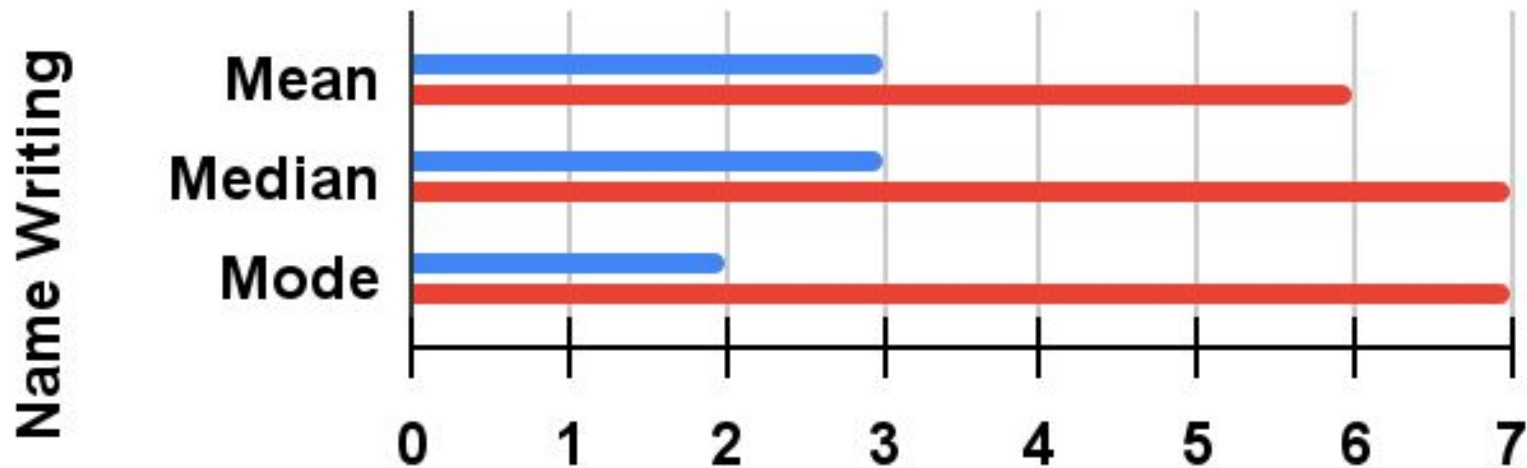
**MEDIAN:** the middle number in a given sequence of numbers

**SPRING DEVELOPMENTAL RANGE:** Expected range of scores for 4Y0 children who are preparing to start kindergarten

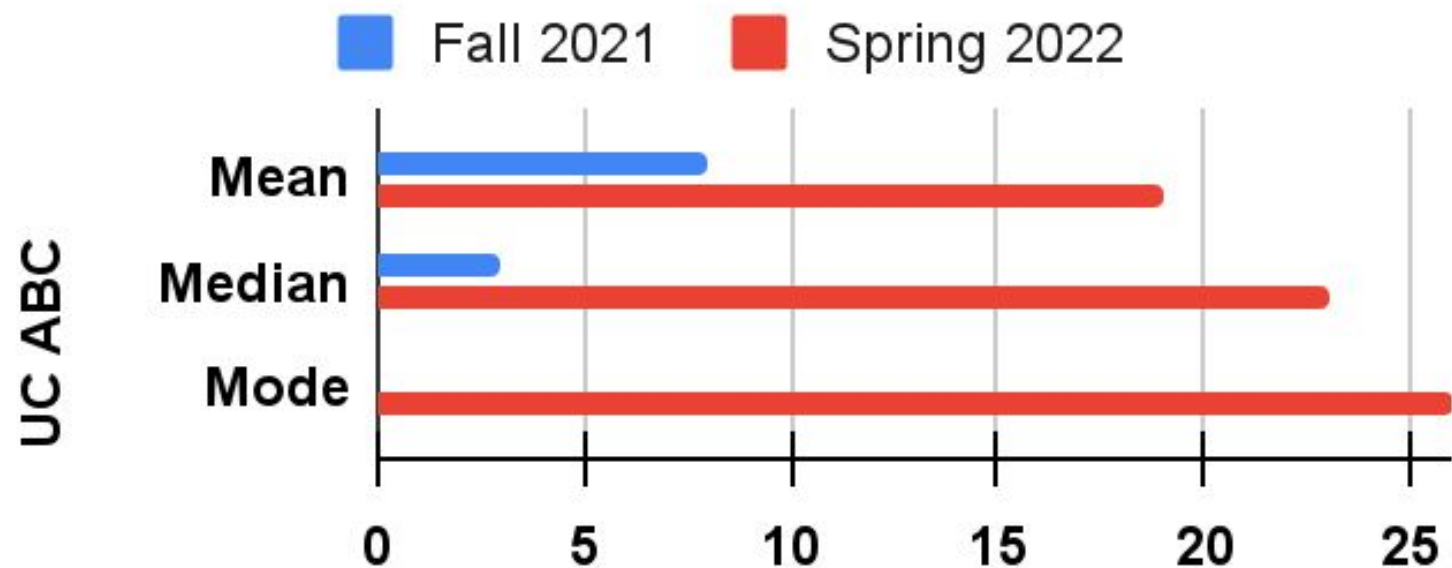

Scores: (Dev. Spring range 5-7)

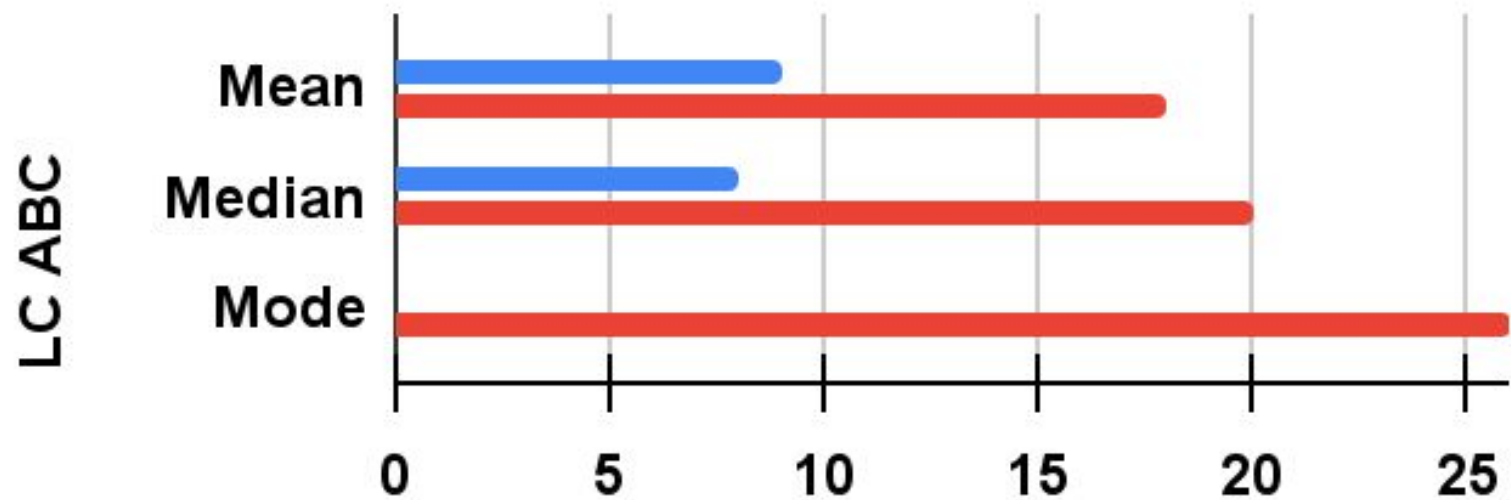
# Upper-Case ABC Recognition

# Lower-Case ABC Recognition

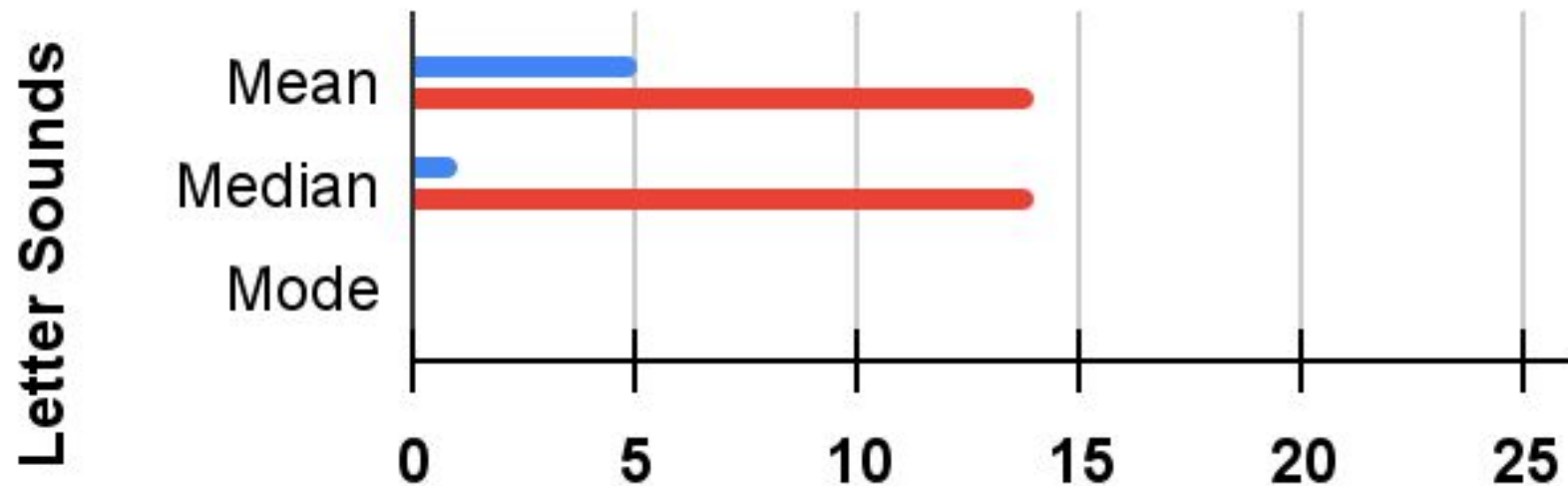

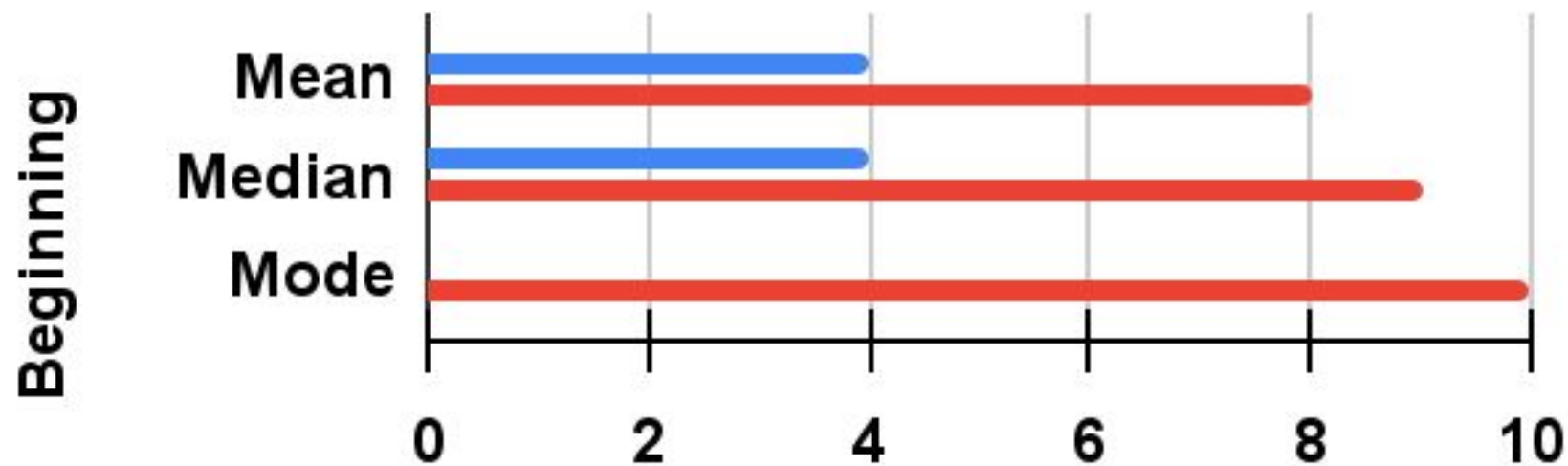

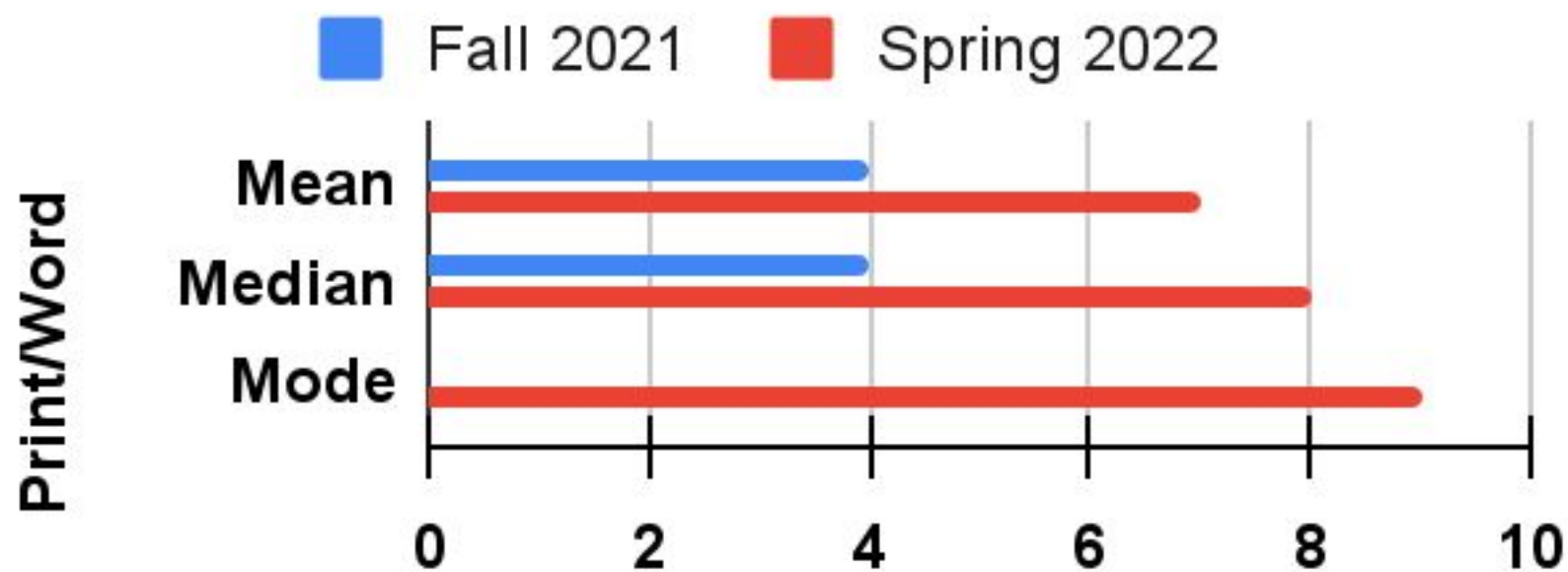
# Beginning Sound Awareness

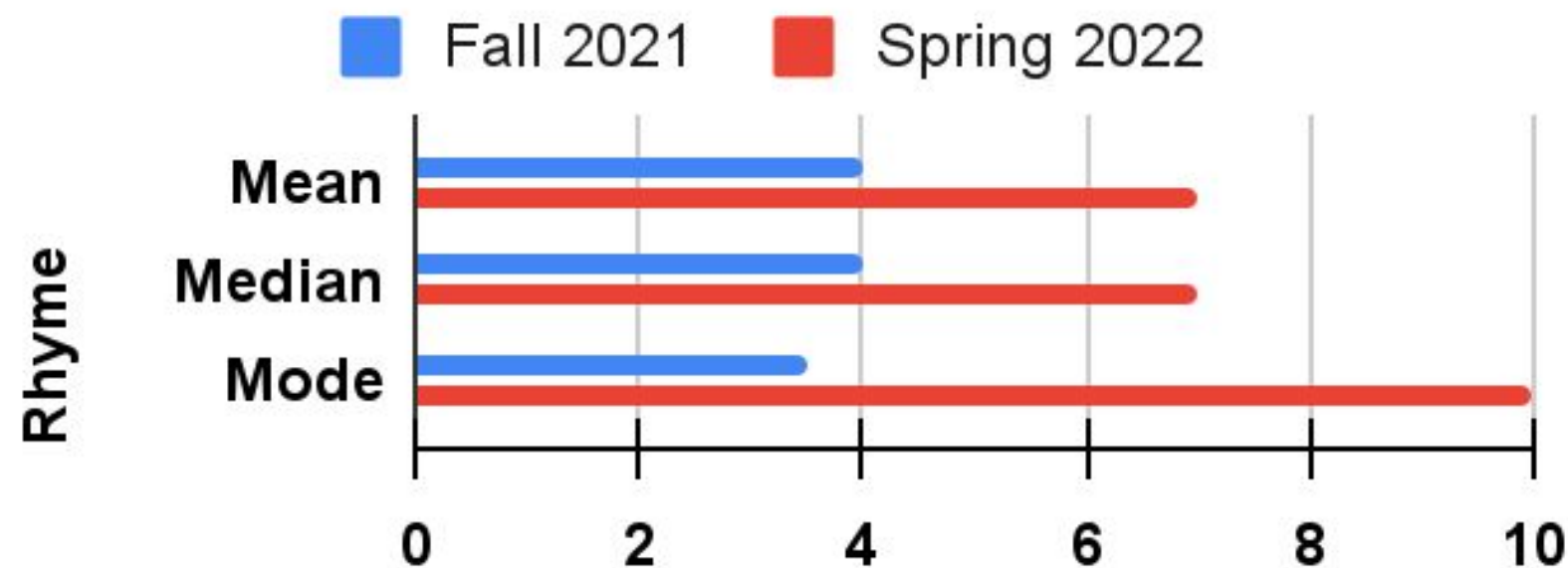
# Print and Word Awareness

# UPDATES:

PALS is updating the screener to reflect the most current evidence base. It is being piloted now across the state.

- • Revise PreK - Grade 3
- • Expand to 3-year-olds
- • New oral language component
- • New and improved online score entry and reporting system

VKRP will show kindergarten readiness across 4 areas (literacy, math, social skills, and self-regulation) and will be more informative than Pre-K PALS alone. This data should be available this summer.
