For the week of 11/21-11/27: 45 cases involving minors

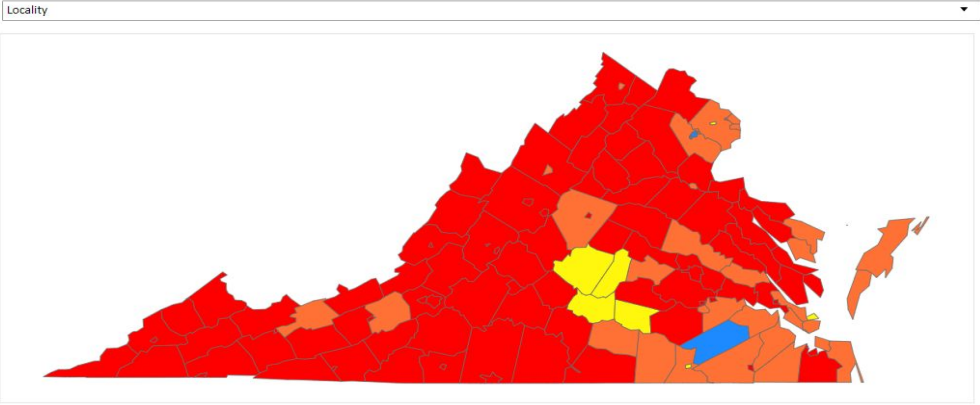
Cases ages 5-11 and 12-18 both down slightly from the week before

385 cases overall in the health district which is very similar to the week before.

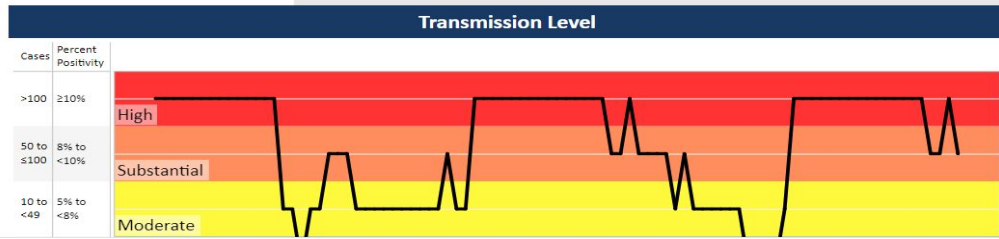

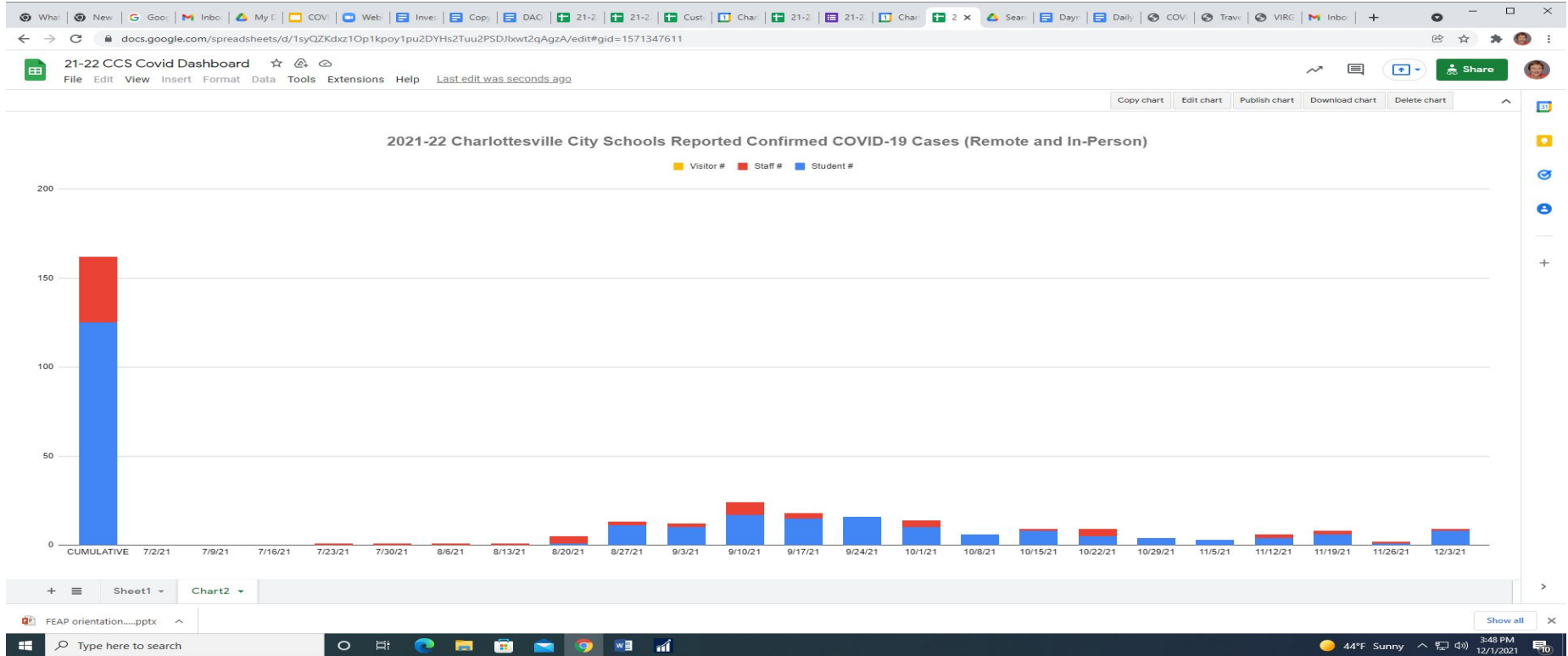

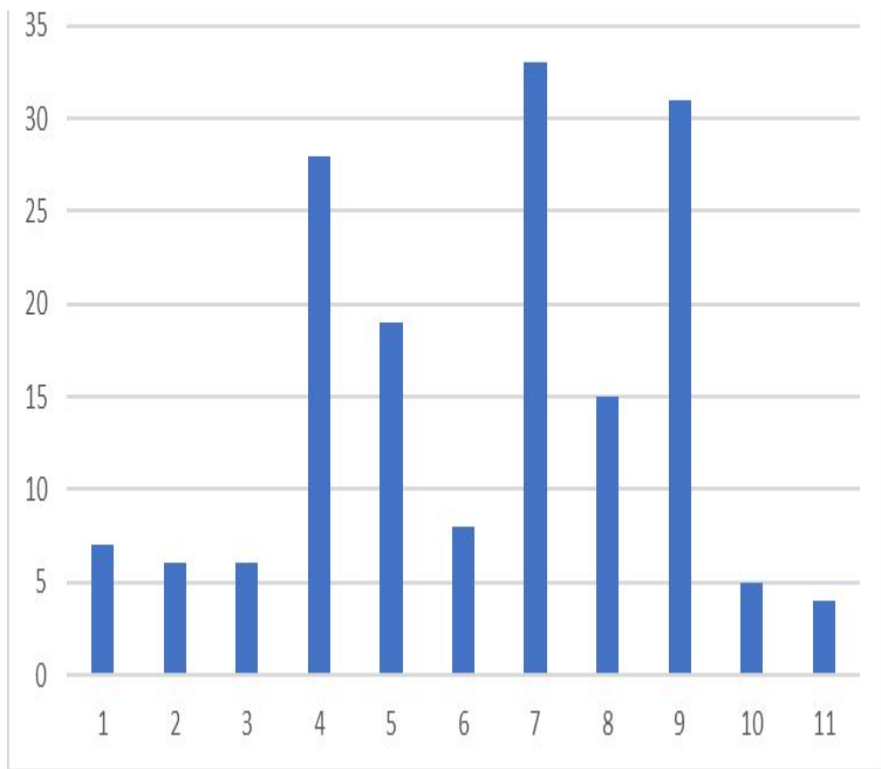

TESTING

We continue to have testing 3 days per week at all school sites through the ViSSTA program. Fortunately we have only identified three positive tests from the beginning.

We also have Binax Rapid Tests for the schools and “Let’s Get Checked” PCR tests that are shipped out.

- all school-based mitigation,
- masking and
- vaccination efforts and/or testing requirements while we are in a small uptick and entering colder weather with more people clustered inside.
