Elementary Class Size

Standard of Quality reporting requires School Boards to report the actual pupil/teacher ratios in elementary classrooms by school. The pupil/teacher ratio includes full-time classroom teachers. The table below summarizes the division's K-3 staffing based on enrollment data as of September 30, 2022. The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) K-3 maximum class size information, based on the school poverty index, is included as a comparison. Each Charlottesville City Schools K-4 elementary school's pupil/teacher ratio is below the VDOE maximum class size.
