- All CCS learners will have access to rigorous, inclusive, and relevant learning experiences.
 - **Target 2:** 100% of graduating students will be equipped with a post-secondary plan.








Which of the following career fields interest you the most?

CATEC - Practical Nursing

- Gives students an option, starting in 10th-grade to follow a pathway in nursing
- Also allows students opportunities to earn multiple credentials:
 - Certified Nurse Aide
 - EKG Technician
 - Practical Nursing
- Students who complete the Practical Nursing program and work in the industry for one year can get the RN program prerequisites waived at community college level making it a shorter pathway to becoming an RN



CATEC-Credit Adjustments

- State sets the number of credits for each course based on the number of hours
- CATEC will align the number of credits awarded based on the state requirements
 - 140 hour course = 1 credit
 - 280 hour course = 2 credits
- CATEC will offset the difference with Career Strategies
 - Students engage in career exploration, career-, & workforce-development
