

What school does your child attend?



Survey Participation 3-4 student survey: 566 responses


Which school do you attend? 564 responses








What is your overall perception of the gifted program? 67 responses




Student Survey:

Student Survey: What do you enjoy about the lessons you get to do with your gifted resource teacher?




Parent Survey: What are the best parts about the gifted program?





Survey participation 5-8 parent survey: 99 responses




Survey participation 5-8 student survey: 596 responses










What best describes the level of challenge in math/language arts?




How often is the math/language arts information interesting and engaging?




