Survey data

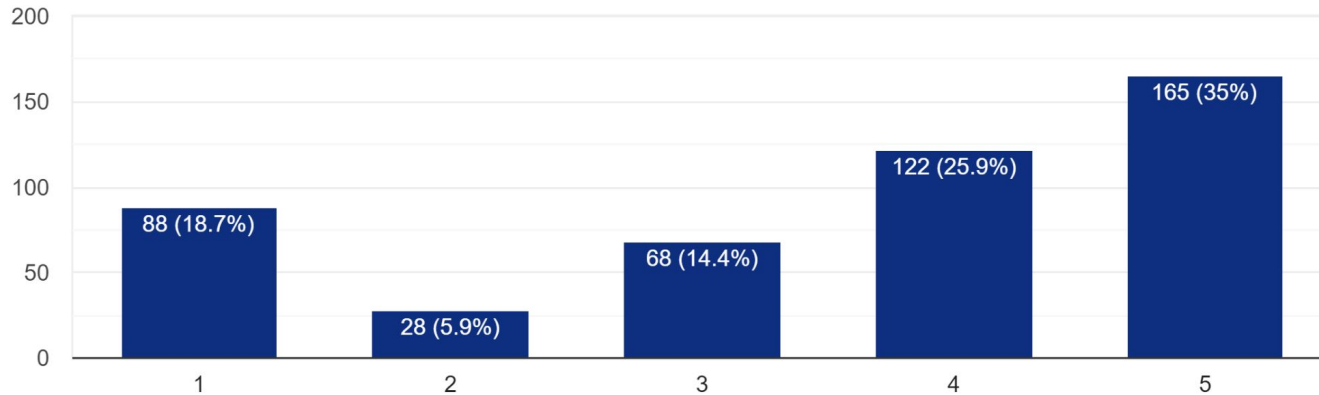
- Survey was opened on 3/12/2023
