I reviewed each application for scoring and submitted my scores to Erin Atak on January 11, 2022. All materials were emailed to me. ● CCS Division Level Equity Committee met Friday, January 28, 2022. I was assigned to the Access and Success Committee. In that meeting we focused on Training and Education.
