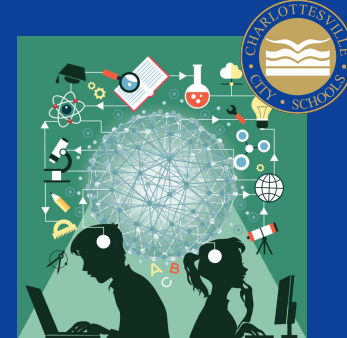


2021 Virtual Instruction Pro (VIP) Awards



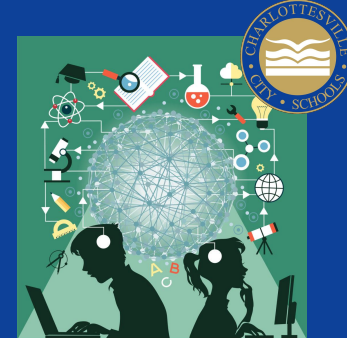

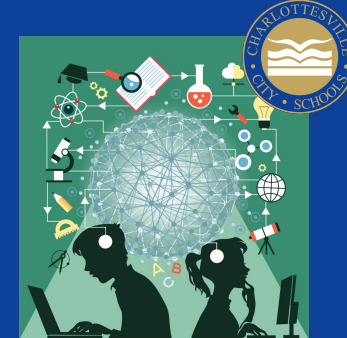
