<p>Fluvanna County</p>	<p>JEC-R1 Non-Resident Student Tuition: The Superintendent shall annually set the tuition to be charged to non-resident students approved for attendance in Fluvanna County Public Schools as provided for in policy JEC School Admission. The amount to be charged shall equal the local expenditure per student, exclusive of capital outlay and debt service. Fluvanna County Public Schools will charge the additional costs of any special education or gifted and talented program provided to the pupil. In the event that the tuition charge is payable by the school board of the school division of the pupil's residence pursuant to a contract entered into between the two school boards, the tuition charge shall be that fixed by such contract. <p>Lexington City</p>	<p>NON-RESIDENT/TUITION STUDENTS will be considered for approval on an individual, first-come, first-serve basis. Class sizes at each grade level are a key consideration for non-resident student approval. <p>Lynchburg City</p>	<p>Non-Resident Student Applications are required each school year from all new and returning students.</p> <p>Non-Resident students who require special services are admitted only on a space available basis due to the special regulations governing those programs. Additional tuition fees for special services will be based on the required services. In addition, students who have been suspended from their former schools or who have poor attendance or disciplinary records are not accepted. Tuition students who become disciplinary problems after enrollment are subject to immediate removal from the school system. On the other hand, the school system is glad to accept serious students who wish to pursue a sound education.</p> <p>Any time during the school year you move outside the city limits, tuition to the Lynchburg Schools is effective at once, for the remainder of the year. You may contact the Lynchburg City Schools’ Finance Office to receive tuition cost information and a tuition application. <p>Falls Church City</p>	<p><i>The policy for the tuition program is not listed in the “JEC” section of the Falls Church City Policy online; however, below is information from their JECZ-R:</i></p> <p>At the direction of the School Board, the Superintendent is extending the non-resident employee student partial tuition waiver program. The program will now allow for enrollment of up to ten (10) nonresident children whose parent(s)/guardian(s) are benefits eligible contracted staff members of the Falls Church City Public Schools. This program allows for admission at a reduced rate of tuition (one-half the annual tuition, unless the student qualifies for free or reduced-price meals, in which case the tuition will be one-quarter the annual tuition). For this program, the School Board has agreed to waive the customary application fee for tuition students outlined in Regulation 9.21. Albemarle County**School Admission Standards for Nonresidents**

Refer to School Board Policy JEC, School Admission, Section II (“Nonresident”) and Section III (“Nonresident Students of Albemarle County Employees”), to determine eligibility for admission to Albemarle County Public Schools on a tuition or non-tuition basis.

Acceptable Conditions for Admission of Nonresidents

- A student whose parent/guardian moves from the county after the end of the first semester may be permitted to complete the school year in his/her current school with no tuition charge.
- A child whose parent/guardian plans to move to the county after the school year begins and who will reside in the county for the majority of the school year may be permitted to begin the school year in an Albemarle County public school (documentation required). Tuition will be charged and held in escrow for the time the parent lives outside the Division and refunded if the parent moves into Albemarle County during the school year.
- A senior whose parent/guardian moves from the county after the end of the first semester of the student’s junior year may be permitted to complete his/her final year in the last high school attended with the payment of tuition.
- A student participating in a foreign exchange program approved by the School Board may attend school in Albemarle County so long as he/she is living with a resident host family.
- A child whose parent/guardian is employed full-time by Albemarle County Public Schools, CATEC, or certain Albemarle County Local Government departments may be admitted on a half-tuition basis.

Procedure for Admission of Nonresident Students

For Albemarle County employees ONLY (paid by the Albemarle County Payroll Department)

Per policy, the eligible child’s parent/guardian must apply for admission by completing a school division application. Applications will be considered on an individual basis and in the order in which they are received, and approval will be contingent upon the availability of class openings and/or services.
