In addition 653 students riding to CCS campuses, Pupil Transportation is:

- Driving 51 students to nine different alternative placements
- Contracting for 5 students transportation

Two additional bus routes will be available starting March 15th
Working to bring an additional driver into service the week of March 27th
Exploring other options to address waitlists

Priorities for Students Needing Transportation:

- Qualifying special needs (IEP's)
- Pre-K students (under VPI transportation cannot be a barrier)
- Tier 3 support students (ELL, etc.)

Siblings of priority students ride as 2nd in seat to maximize bus capacity.

Access to the routes/stops is also a consideration for waitlist decisions.

Walk to School

Walking School Buses

A walking school bus is a group of children walking to school with one or more adults

Bike to School

• Bike Trains

A variation on the walking school bus is the bicycle train, in which adults supervise children riding their bikes to school

Car Transportation

Multiple drop off points and off-campus drop off points (staffed & coordinated with community as needed) can help if car traffic becomes problematic
