**Chronic Absenteeism Monthly Report: March**

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A written report will be provided to the school board monthly regarding chronic absenteeism data. The information will include the data as it stands at the end of each month.

## Information regarding the data:

- The number of days adjusts based on the membership days.
- The data does not reflect adjustments that occur after the end of the school year:
  - Days recouped by flexible, in-person instruction
  - Students removed from the calculation due to homebound status at any point in the year
- The data reflects all CCS students including students who have transferred out, students enrolled in public and private separate schools, and students in residential placements through the Community Services Board (CSB).
- Previous monthly rates may change based on updated guidance and improvements to our process.
- School days that we received waivers for are included in this calculation.

#### What is chronic absenteeism?

Chronic absenteeism is a calculation including excused and unexcused absences. A student is
chronically absent if at any point in the year they have accumulated absences of 10% or more
excluding religious observances and extended medical absences with doctor's orders. Students who
are homebound at any point in the school year cannot be chronically absent. Days of suspension
contribute toward the chronic absenteeism calculation.

### What is truancy?

Truancy is being absent from school without notification - these are unverified or unexcused absences.
 Attendance plans and conferences are required based on unexcused absences and must be complete by the final SRC after the conclusion of the school year.

#### March Celebration:
